The breed is part 'bull' & part 'terrier' & should not lean heavily towards either way, as breeders please be mindful of BBC - Blend, Balance & Conformation.

There ere a few mouth faults but I prefer to look for the virtues, which far outweighed thwm.

Dogs

6-9 Month Dogs

1. Adorabulls Dark Knight

Black/brindle. Lovely clean head, with dark eyes, neat ears, clean lipped, good bite, nice front, good top-line. Overall developing nicely & moved well.

2. Elivad's Wanderlust

Black/brindle. Slightly bigger than 1. Good rear & front with nicely developing body. Dark eyes, neat ears, correct bite. Moved OK.

12-18 Month Dogs

1. Thomstaffs Golden Destiny (WD & AOM)

Tiger Brindle. Strong headed dog, with dark eyes, tidy ears, good reach of neck, ample rib, powerful rear quarters, correct tail placement. Level top-line head on the move. Moved with drive.

2. Felizstaff the Tears of a Clown

Black/brindle. Short coupled compact dog, with straight front, ample bone, good feet. Moved well. This young dog has a really nice head with good proportions, neat ears & dark eyes.

Bred by Exhibitor Dogs

1. Daydream New Dawns Fade (RWD)

Black/brindle. Clean headed dog with keen expression, which demands a second look. Excellent pigmentation throughout. Would like to see a little more spring of rib & pushed hard for WD. Moved well & handled effortlessly.

2. Nevadas Little White Lies

White. Good head, tight lipped, correct bite, strong underjaw, good reach of neck leading to good front & shoulders. Short coupled. Strong rear quarters. Moved well.

American Bred Dog

1. Tomorrow's One Love

Red. Nice shaped head, strong muzzle, dark eyes, neat ears. Short compact body. Well, developed rear. Moved well

## Open Dogs

### 1. Daydream Kissing to Be Clever

Black/brindle. Top draw dog. Very nice head, with lovely dark eyes, neat ears, strong underjaw, good bite. Ample rib, level top-line, good tail carriage.

### 2. Star'z Pog Mo Thoin

Red. Strong dog. Good head with rose ears, good bite & underjaw. Ample bone, good front. Short coupled, level top-line held on move.

## Bitches

### 6-9 Month Bitch

#### 1. Sassafras's Shake Your Tail Feather

Black/white pied. Being a little minx today & eventually moved OK. Clean lipped with strong underjaw, good bite, neat ears, dark eyes. Maturing nicely with ample bone.

#### 2. Adorable Dreamweaver

Black/brindle. Longer cast than 1. Straight front, nice shoulders, level top-line, ribs beginning to spring. Nice angulated rear. Moved OK.

### 9-12 Month Bitch

#### 1. Redwood Coast Spin the Wind

White. Mature bitch with lovely front & shoulders. Neat ears, dark eyes, clean lipped, good bite. Level top-line held on the move. Good spring of rib. Moved effortlessly.

### 12-18 Month Bitch

#### 1. Felizstaffs Fifth Element.

Black/brindle. Dark eyed, clean lipped, neat ears, lovely expression, correct bite, good front & feet, sprung rib with level top-line held on move. Looked good for & aft.

#### 2. Felizstaffs I'd Rather Go Blind

Black/brindle. Very similar attributes to one, but not the same condition.

### Bred by Exhibitor Bitch

#### 1. Redwood Coast She's A Peach

Red. Tidy girl with charming expression. Nice head, good body & well sprung rib. Ample bone, moved & presented well.

#### 2. Sassafras's Dramatic Entrance

Black/brindle. Nicely conditioned, well balanced, with dark eyes, neat ears, clean muzzle, moved OK.

### American Bred Bitch

#### 1. Classy Staffy's Mistletoe Kiss.

Red. Clean headed, good expression, tidy ears, round eyes, good front & shoulders, short coupled, level top-line, tidy feet, moved well.

### Open Bitch

#### 1. Kronsaters Tarantella (WB, BOW & BOS)

Black/brindle. Quite outstanding girl, the blend I like to see. Super head, dark round eyes, clean tight lips, with correct bite. Good straight front & shoulders well laid. Superb condition.

Ran the dog very close for BOB.

2. L-Bell's Order of The Pheonix At Lore (RWB)

Black/brindle. Pretty bitch with nice expression. Dark round eyes & neat ears, good bite. Nice body with straight front, level top-line, moved well.

Best Veteran

1. GChB Quinlent Awake My Soul (BOB)

What a cracking veteran, what a star & what a mover!

Red/white pied. Standard dog. Well-muscled rear quarters, on a short compact body, with good spring of rib, straight front & good strong shoulders. Nice tight feet.

Wonderfully proportioned head, with nice ears & dark eyes. Moved with drive & purpose. Despite his eight years I gave him BOB & would have loved him to be mine & yes, I did see his teeth, but at eight years of age I gave him a break.

Select Dog - Ch Phylaw Full Metal Jacket

White. Strong head, distinct stop, neat ears, dark eyes. Short coupled compact body, with straight front, tight feet, powerful rear, handled well, moved effortlessly.

Select Bitch - GCHB Dynastaff Don't Leave Home Without It

Brindle. Quality bitch shown in excellent condition & very well handled. Well, proportioned head, rose ears, dark eyes, straight front, good depth of brisket, well sprung ribs, short coupled.
